Welcome letter by the ESNA President (Prof. Stefano Grego)

Dear Colleagues:

On behalf of the ESNA Committee it is my pleasure to invite you to participate in the XLV (45th) Annual Meeting of our Society, to be held in Belgrade, a city at the confluence of the rivers Danube and Sava. Belgrade is a nice historical location, well-known as a city at historical crossroad.

The venue of the ESNA meeting is Faculty of Agriculture University of Belgrade

The Faculty of Agriculture has long tradition, it is a teaching and research institution whose activities cover all aspects of agricultural production and food technology: crop science, fruit science and viticulture, animal science, soil management, phytomendicine, agricultural engineering, food technology and agricultural economics. Since its foundation in 1919 about 16.000 students have gained BS degree, 900 MS degree and 750 PhD degrees.

The Faculty is organized in 31 departments and eight Institutes. The Faculty has a Central Laboratory, an Office for Student affairs, Central Library, as well as a Technical and Administrative Services. From 1941/42 the FoA has an experimental school estate "Radmilovac", of about 100 ha, a legacy of the family Vukicevic. There are about 300 teaching staff and 200 employees. The enrolment of students is up to 1.000 students per year. 370 students graduate, 30 receive MS degree and 20 PhD degrees annually.

Faculty of Agriculture organizes a number of scientific and professional meetings on a regular basis and with national and international participation (Animal Sciences, Aquaculture, Bee and honey production, Crop Sciences, Phytomendicine, Agricultural Mechanization, Food technology, Milk production, Agroeconomy), as also publishing scientific results in national and international printed and electronic publications, as well as the "Journal of Agricultural Sciences".

Following the decision of the ESNA General Assembly, taken in at the end of the our organization's IXLV Meeting, and successfully experimented in the recent past meetings we will have many common scientific activities, and this year's main theme regards different aspects of environmental protection and application of new methods and biotechnologies in agricultural research

I am sure that this system will work again and I strongly invite you to submit papers to the common sections.

I look forward to meeting you here in September, 2016!

Please timely book accommodation, because the prices are promotional, and the number of rooms is limited. Please let us know in what hotel you will be staying.

Also, organizer can arrange a good private accommodation in city, but you have to apply this request to the secretary of the conference earlier (Jun/July).

For students, but also and for participants which tend to lower the cost of accommodation, there is an option to book accommodation in student's dormitory. This option concerns renovated facilities which are only few blocks away from the Faculty od Agriculture (four bus stations, bus 45). Also, beside a breakfast, a dinner could be also included in this offer. Price of this accommodation should be significantly cheaper than commercial accommodation, and participants which tends to take this option should apply this request to the secretary of the conference earlier (Jun/July).

ATHER INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANTS

Transfer from the airport to hotel

Belgrade Nikola Tesla Airport is located 18 kilometers away from the city center.

The price of a taxi service from the airport is divided into 6 zones. Hotels located in Novi Beograd ('Crowne Plaza', 'Tulip Inn') and Zemun ('Lav') are in the first zone and the price is 1,400-1600 RSD (about 12 EUR). Hotels 'Jump Inn' and 'Majdan' are in the second zone and the price is 1,800 RSD (about 15 EUR).

There is also a public bus line (No. 72), but it is a long journey and the stations are not very close to hotels.

Transfer from hotels to symposium events

On Tuesday, September 5, **welcome cocktail** will be organized at the Faculty of Agriculture, Zemun, Nemanjina 6.

Transport (or small walk) for participants will also be organized/guided for the **Official dinner** on Wednesday, September, 7, depending on a number of participants as well as for the excursion on Thursday, September, 8. Schedule will be announced during the symposium.

Belgrade public transportation

I recommend you to buy tickets for one day (280 RSD or 2.3 EUR), three days (720 RSD or 6 EUR). Tickets can be bought at kiosks and in small shops with a sign "Bus Plus". You can also buy single tickets in the bus from the driver. The price for a ride is 150 RSD (about 1.25 EUR).

Parking

The venue, Faculty of Agriculture, has a large free public parking. Currency

The Serbian **Dinar** (RSD) is the currency of Serbia. Exchange rates are approximately: 1 EUR = 123 RSD 1 USD = 108 RSD

In Serbia, it is not officially possible to pay in foreign currency. Only taxi drivers sometimes accept Euros. The best exchange rates are in the small exchange offices in the street. There is an exchange office at the airport. In the vicinity of Faculty there are ATM machines (bancomat).,
